MEETINGS AND ACTIVITY

We want our chapters to be active. This means getting together, building each other up as brothers and sisters, and doing things to improve the state of our local communities.

Some things your chapter should do: have meetings, get involved with other local groups, raise money for charitable things, do marches or parades, get involved with campus activism, etc.



WHAT WE WANT TO BE

We would like to see young traditionalists in modest and formal attire. Members should behave in a sophisticated and Christian manner.

Demonstrations should be kept clean; in other words, members should not get in the faces of opposition and act aggressively. The misled souls of our community may sometimes be angry at our beliefs, but we must face their anger with maturity.

Women can be a part of our demonstrations as well, and are also encouraged to dress formally. Men should lead protests/marches, and women can pass out fliers or talk to bystanders. Chapter leads should find a way, depending on the event, to coordinate men and women to work together in harmony.



Men should wear suits, preferably in black or grey with a white dress shirt with a tie. If women are involved, they should wear a black or grey ankle-length skirt and white dress shirt.

Take weather into consideration.



There are many other activist groups that hold similar values to us, but often end up looking like the picture above. We try to avoid this because we are non-violent group; our true goal is to restore Christian values in the community.



WHAT WE DO NOT WANT TO BE

We do not want to be another politicized right-vs-left group. While representing us, we ask that your chapter avoids political flags/apparel. In other words, we don't want the media to label this as "another Trump thing."

We also do not want to see men with plate carriers and siege masks. This is not something that should look threatening. We are trying to be serious.

Christian flags and American flags are encouraged, but please keep American flags in their red, white, and blue state (no modifications).



WHY WE HOST MARCHES/PROTESTS

Our activist front is one of our key strategies, but why? One benefit of our activism is that we may help others in our community to see the world from a traditionalist perspective.

While that is one benefit, our main focus is also to raise the morale of like-minded people who have given up. So many people, both young and old, are losing hope. If they see Christian men and women on a street corner, dressed nicely, still proud of their nation, still advocating for a return to traditional values, it will inspire them.

Our ultimate goal is to inspire others: to take their hopelessness and turn it into passion. Maybe some will want to join us, others may just kindle a desire to return to the old ways. Ultimately, activism helps us achieve a better community in this way.





A BENEFIT OF HAVING A CHAPTER

Outside of activism, we encourage chapter members to share their craft with each other. Chapters should be a well-bonded group of believers who share skills, trades, and ideas to push the best out of each other.
